'Fellowship of the Church' by Pastor Mike

How wonderful it is for the Church to have fellowship once again! After experiencing lock downs this year, we certainly do appreciate being able to enjoy fellowship together!

But the Church fellowship is more than just 'being together'. The important element that makes true fellowship is 'having (something) in common'.

We read then, of the first mention of the word 'fellowship' in the Book of Acts, and indeed in my Bible, the word 'fellowship' is first found here in the Book of Acts:

"And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers." - Acts 2:42

'Fellowship' is something that the original Church started to practice or do straight away! It was a natural and normal thing for the Church to start doing and wanting to do!

Look carefully in the verse at what the fellowship was originally centred around...it was the teaching of the Apostles, the breaking of bread and prayers. But in full understanding of the Church's commitment to this, it reads "And they devoted themselves to...". Wow!

This kind of commitment and devotion to the *fellowship* brought with it an incredible harvest of blessings and growth in the early Church. See the following...

1. The Church was Unified

"And all who believed were together and had all things in common." - Acts 2:44

2. The Church was Magnified

"Praising God and having favour with all the people." - Acts 2:47a

3. The Church was Multiplied

"And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved." - Acts 2:47b

What a powerful testimony the early Church had to the unbelieving Jews in Jerusalem, not only because of the miracles done by the Apostles, but because of the 'fellowship' within the Church, as they devoted themselves to the teaching of the Apostles, breaking of bread and prayer.

This demonstrated their love and commitment to each other and to how they were serving the Lord!

Here are a few more great Bible verses related to fellowship that we can be blessed by:

"God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord." - 1 Corinthians 1:9

"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all." - 2 Corinthians 13:14

Praise the Lord for powerful fellowship amongst us! Let's see what the Lord can do through it!
