PASTORS COLUMN: Revival is the Exaltation of Christ above self! - by Ptr. Mike.

A revived heart has one ambition - to exalt Jesus Christ.

This is because revival comes as we see the Lord high and lifted up. Either on the cross, or wearing His crown. In fact, one should lead to the other!

When Christ is lifted up, it is first and foremost because he is holy. As the Prophet Isaiah said when he saw the vision of the Lord "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" - Isaiah 6:3

With that holy sight, the Prophet saw the need to repent as he replied "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips;"

From repentant hearts of ourselves then, we will want everyone to know the reality of Christ's holiness and to see him exalted. *Revival isn't about us; it is about Jesus!*

Exalt Christ Personally

We easily build the idol of 'self' in our hearts. But a revived heart desires to see Jesus exalted above self.

A revived heart personally has fellowship with Christ, desiring his truth, from the innermost part of their being. The evidence of such a heart is loving the Lord, walking with the Lord, and rejoicing in the Lord.

A). Love the Lord. Love him in accordance with his Word. "And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength." - Mark 12:30. Such a heart and love, is exalting the person or object of that love. In this case the Lord your God, because He has revived the heart.

Are our hearts satisfied in the love of God, exalting Him? Or, do we love and exalt something or someone else? Is our love given to 'idols', or whole heartedly to the Lord?

B). Walk with the Lord. Colossians 3:3-4 says "For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory."

How then can we walk with Christ if we have died as the verse above says? It is because we walk with Christ in the new life of Christ, as it says "Christ who is your life..." This is the new life, the resurrected life, which is the 'power of God' life in the believer that exalts Christ. This is the only life that can walk with the Lord. The old 'self and sin life' cannot exalt Christ, and neither does it want to, because it is not a life based on God's truth.

Are we walking with the Lord in the new life, so that the life we now live, is exalting Him?

C). Rejoice in the Lord. In revival, whether personal or public, Church or community, true rejoicing happens because it is in the Lord. In reality, the rejoicing is not just because of revival, it is because of the Lord!

"May my meditation be pleasing to him, for I rejoice in the LORD." - Psalm 104:34

Rejoicing in the Lord therefore is a rejoicing that will truely exalt Him. Many people rejoice when they get what they want, or their favourite sports team wins, or even when a new born baby is born, and this is perfectly normal. But these things are temporary by nature, and so the rejoicing will be also.

So much more will our rejoicing be, all the day long, every day, when we know that our life, has been *revived* in our heart and in our walk, for all eternity, to exalt the Lord forever! God bless.
