PASTORS COLUMN: Repentance in Revival and Revival in Repentance - Ptr. Mike

Perhaps we want to see a great turning toward God in our community or a renewed fervency for Him among Christians. But we tend to forget where Revival begins, and that beginning is with personal repentance. Revival comes to a humbled heart. There is no short cut - no magic formula where we can avoid repentance and personally dealing with *self and sin*.

God doesn't send Revival because we are so *right*, but because we are willing to humble ourselves before Him, and acknowledge that we are so *wrong*. The Apostle Paul talks about a certain kind of personal sorrow and grief: "For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death." 1 Corinthians 7:10. Even the Church at Ephesus needed reviving, and in doing so Christ didn't skip over repentance: "Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. If not, I will come to you and remove your lamp stand from it's place, unless you repent." Revelation 2:5

Andrew Murray once said, "A true revival means nothing less than a revolution, casting out the spirit of worldliness and selfishness, and making God and his love triumph in the heart and life." Revival therefore will be in Repentance, and Repentance will be in Revival!

Here are 2 key points:

1. Awaken me Lord, so that I will see sin as it truely is.

In 1 Corinthians 15:34, we see a spiritual awakening and rejection of sin as simultaneous choices: "Wake up from your drunken stupor, as is right, and do not go on sinning..."

Often we are happy to see sin as something less than the ugly rebellion against God that it is. Instead of seeing sin as a life-threatening infection, we see it as a 'sometimes-annoying-pet' which causes the occasional inconvenience, but is otherwise worth keeping around. But if we desire a godly spiritual awakening in our lives, we cannot allow sin to continue to have its way in our hearts.

Scripture tells us about two kinds of sin. The first is the sin of *commission*, that is sin we willingly commit. This is when God says "No", but we say "Yes". It is when God says "Don't", but we say "I will "

The second kind of sin is the sin of *omission*, that is sin by omitting what we know to be right. This is when God says "Do", but we simply ignore Him or say "I won't". James 4:17 describes this type of sin: "So whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin."

2. Now that I'm awake Lord, help me to turn from the sin that I see.

Repentance is not something we conjure up - personally or corporately- through casting guilt or wallowing in shame. True repentance is a work of the Holy Spirit who will "convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgement" (John 16:8).

The Holy Spirit faithfully uses the Word of God, which is "living and active, sharper than any two edged sword...discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12)

But if we are to desire the Holy Spirit's work of conviction, we must expose our hearts to His Word and humbly and openly pray, "Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!" (Psalm 139:23-24)

A heart that is personally desiring to live right and to please the Lord, will no doubt need on-going times of repentance, but will also experience the refreshment of *Revival from God!*

So let us desire Revival, but first let us all desire Repentance. May God bring His awakening!
